

# Musical Theatre & Voice Recital 2017: “New York, New York”

Recital season is almost here! Recital is an incredibly fun and rewarding experience for our students and their families! We have found that the show and rehearsals run very smoothly when everyone follows a few simple policies and procedures. ***Please take the time to read this entire packet.*** If by chance you lose your recital packet, you will be able to find the entire document on our website. We hope that this information will answer your questions and ensure a wonderful show for all involved!

## Dress Rehearsals

\* Both dress rehearsals and recitals take place at TCC Van Trease PACE located at 81<sup>st</sup> and HWY 169 \*

Dress rehearsal is mandatory. ***Students who do not participate in their dress rehearsal for any reason will not be able to participate in recital.*** We conduct dress rehearsals in the exact order of recital so that students feel adequately prepared for the show with costume changes, etc. We will only stop during dress rehearsal in the case of a true emergency. Organizing rehearsals in this formal manner allows us to enhance our students' understanding and education of the professional performance experience.

All students will rehearse in full costume with proper shoes and accessories. All female students must wear make-up on stage. Lipstick, blush, and eye make-up are a necessity. Please arrive to dress rehearsal and recital in performance make-up with your hair styled appropriately for your first number. We recommend having the student's name in *each* costume piece, their finale t-shirt, and *each* of their shoes. No nail polish or jewelry should be worn unless specified by your teacher. No underwear is to be worn under girls' tight fitted costumes. This applies to both dress rehearsals and performances. Teachers will be passing out final accessory sheets detailing tights, shoes, and hairstyles in student' classes this week. **No food or drinks will be allowed backstage or in the auditorium.**

## **Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup>**

**5:00 pm Recital #3 Dress Rehearsal (3:00 p.m. show) at TCC Van Trease PACE**

\*\*\* IMPORTANT \*\*\* There are *no Musical Theatre* classes or Private Voice Lessons at Theatre Arts on this day as all instructors will be at TCC.

Doors will open at **4:00 pm** and all students must be in their designated dressing rooms by **4:30 pm**. This will give students ample time to change into their first costume, if needed, and ready to rehearse as scheduled. At each dress rehearsal, we will run through the finale FIRST at **5:00 pm** sharp. We will then run the entire show in order, and you and your student are free to leave after you have finished rehearsing your number(s).

TCC has requested that no entries be made through the main lobby doors. When arriving at TCC, please use the lower south lobby entrance, the first set of glass doors to the left of the main entrance (there will be signs posted for both rehearsals and recitals directing you). Once inside, performers must enter through the studio theatre doors on the left and a parent may take students directly to their dressing room (there will be signs posted for both rehearsals and recitals to direct you). Once the student is in their dressing room, all observers should remain in the lobby until the house is opened. Students must remain backstage for the ENTIRE recital. No students will be allowed to leave the backstage area with a parent to watch part of the recital from the house. This is for the student's safety and will be strictly enforced. Theatre Arts staff must know where each student is for the duration of the show.

# Policies and Procedures

1. Account balances through May (tuition, costumes, and fees) must be paid in full BEFORE dress rehearsal for your student's participation.
2. **No one is allowed back stage once the show & rehearsals have started other than performers and designated class moms.** The recital slideshow will begin as soon as the house doors open so you will definitely want to be in your seats 30 minutes prior to the show to avoid missing out!
3. Absolutely no food, drinks, or gum allowed in any dressing room.
4. **A parent or relative must come to the black box theatre after the show to sign out their student.**  
**\*\*NEW THIS YEAR, no student will be allowed to leave during the recital under any circumstances.**  
**All students must stay backstage for the duration of the show. Each show will be under 2 ½ hours.**

## Additional Information

**Class Photos :** More information is attached about group pictures. Group and individual pictures will be taken May 6-7<sup>th</sup> at Theatre Arts. We are thrilled to have Francine's Photography doing our recital pictures this year! Students must come in full costume, make-up, and hair for photos. We strongly encourage all students to attend their scheduled picture day to make for excellent group photos whether or not you are planning to purchase the photos. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your student's scheduled time so that the day runs smoothly and on time.

**Parent Volunteers (Purple Form):** Volunteers are needed to supervise younger students backstage. All parent volunteers will receive one free recital DVD for each shift they work. Please see attached purple form with more information.

**Recital T-Shirts & Finale:** Students of all levels and all ages participating in recital are invited to participate in our finale number, which closes the show! ALL students will learn this fun song & dance in their weekly class. All students participating in the recital will receive a recital t-shirt. Students will wear their recital t-shirt with any shorts or pants of their choice for the finale.
